Melissa Theresa Durocher, a life-long resident of Nashua, NH died unexpectedly at home of a long-term cardiac condition on June 5, 2021 at the age of 47.

Melissa was born in Nashua on January 30, 1974 to Maurice and the late Pamela (Bellefeuille) Durocher. She graduated from Mt. Saint Mary Seminary in 1992. Melissa then received an associate's in business degree from Castle College in 1994 and a bachelor's degree in computer information systems from Rivier College in 1996. She worked in the medical insurance claims processing field for many years. She was employed at SolutionHealth, Nashua. Previous employers were Cigna Health and Aetna.
