Richard M. Quinlan, 55, of Hudson, N.H. died Friday May 20, 2011 at Lahey Clinic in Burlington, MA surrounded by friends and family after a valiant battle against brain cancer. He leaves behind his wife of seventeen years, Suellen Seabury, and a beloved daughter, Emily Ann Quinlan.

A 1974 graduate of Lexington High School, Richard went on to serve proudly in the U.S. Army. After his discharge, he went on to Medford Vocational Technical School and became a licensed pipefitter and oil heat technician. He worked on "the big ships" at Quincy shipyard and for several Boston-area heating and plumbing shops. He also worked for many years as a plumber at BTU International in Billerica, MA and more recently for the P.M. MacKay Group in Nashua, NH.

Richard was a kind and quiet gentleman who loved his home, his family and an iced cold beer on a hot summer's day. He was an avid Boston sports fan, golf enthusiast and fisherman. He was a communicant of Blessed John XXIII parish in Hudson and Nashua.

Besides his wife and daughter, Richard leaves behind his mother, Rosalyn Quinlan, of Lexington, MA and four sisters: Elaine Quinlan of Lexington, MA; Estelle Hutchinson and her husband, Robert, of Warwick, RI; Anita Rowley and her husband, Charles, of Waltham, MA; and Madalyn Quinlan and her husband, Brian Garrity, of Helena, MT. He also leaves behind his nephews, Ian and Drew Hutchinson and Brett Rowley. Richard's loving father, Martin J. Quinlan, predeceased him.
