



## Robert Kennedy

April 29, 1948 - May 8, 2016

Robert Kennedy, 68, of Litchfield, passed away peacefully on Sunday, May 8, 2016, at the Manchester VA Medical Center.

He was born on April 29, 1948 in Stoneham, MA to the late Daniel J. Kennedy and Virginia (Hunt) Kennedy. He was a graduate of Lexington High School and Wentworth Institute of Technology. He was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps and served in Vietnam.

Robert worked primarily as the Corporate Quality Manager at Digital Equipment Corporation for nearly twenty years, worked as a freelance consultant and then retired from Mercury Computers in Chelmsford, MA.

He is survived by his wife of 41 years, Dolores "Dolly" (Brousseau) Kennedy; his children and their spouses, Sean and Kelley Kennedy, Shannon and Andrew Cutter, and Ryan and Jenn Kennedy, all of Litchfield. He has 4 grandchildren, Evan Kennedy, Aidan Kennedy, Reagan Cutter and Grant Cutter. He is also survived by a brother, James Kennedy and his wife Patricia Kennedy of Nashua, NH and a sister, Janice Pinkham of Hampstead, NH. He is also survived by many nieces and nephews. He is predeceased by his son Brennan Kennedy, who passed away in 2007.

Robert will be remembered as a loving husband and father. Known as Pops to his grandchildren, there was no greater pleasure in his life than spending time with them. He was an award winning scale model builder, with models on display at the Wright Museum in Wolfeboro, NH. He was also an avid reader of nearly every subject and people always fought to be on his team for Trivial Pursuit.
