



Theodore Pobywajlo

March 3, 1939 - November 29, 2014

Theodore (Ted) Pobywajlo, 75, of Bedford, NH, died of internal injuries sustained in a pedestrian/vehicle accident on Saturday, November 29, 2014.

Born March 3, 1939 in Kiev, Ukraine, Ted was the son of the late Odakim and Warwara Pobywajlo. During World War II, Ted's family migrated to Germany where they lived in Displaced Persons camps for several years. They immigrated to the United States and settled in Buffalo, NY. After graduating from Seneca Vocational High School, Ted joined the U.S. Air Force and served for eight years.

Ted was the loving husband of Margaret Pobywajlo of Bedford with whom he shared 42 years of marriage and two daughters. For 31 years, Ted worked as a logistician at the New Boston satellite tracking station. After retiring in 2004, Ted enjoyed spending more time with his family, especially his grandchildren.

In addition to his wife, Ted is survived by two daughters, Tricia Wajda and her husband John W. Wajda, Jr. and Susan Pobywajlo, and two grandsons, Jack and Elliot Wajda, all of Boston Massachusetts. He is also survived by two brothers, Walter and Nick Pobywajlo, and three sisters Anna Franciso, Nadia Hrynczyszyn, and Kathryn Koly, as well as many nieces and nephews.
