Adele F. (Sanuth) Brydges, 93 passed away peacefully on Friday, May 29th 2026 at St Francis Rehabilitation and Nursing Home in Laconia, NH

Adele was born on November 2nd 1932 in Boston, the second youngest of 12 children. She was the daughter of the late Louis and Apoline (Minkauskas) Sanuth, both emigre's from Lithuania.

Adele was raised in Hyde Park and attended the Catholic parochial Most Precious Blood School until the 10th grade.
