



ALBERT H. COFFEY

April 26, 1922 - December 15, 2012

Albert Henderson Coffey, 90 of Nashua, died Saturday December 15, 2012 at Langdon Place of Nashua.

He was born April 26, 1922 in Nashua, son of the late Dr. Albert G. and Korleen (Henderson) Coffey. Albert was also predeceased by his son Albert W. Coffey in 1994 as well as by his first wife, Marion (Falvey) Coffey in 1957 and his second wife, Florence (Birge) Ennis Coffey in 1995. He was also predeceased by his brothers; Conrad J. Coffey in 1996 and Dr. Donald C. Coffey in 2000.

Albert was a WWII Army Veteran where he served as a Medical Technician in the New Guinea campaign. Throughout his life, Albert was very active in the Boy Scouts of America, of which he was an Eagle Scout, and the James E. Coffey Post, American Legion in Nashua. He was employed for many years with the United States Air Force at Hanscom Air Force Base in Massachusetts where he worked in logistics management. He was also a member of the Nashua Elks Lodge 720 and the VFW Post 483 in Nashua. Albert especially enjoyed spending time and laughs with many close friends, fellow veterans, and family.

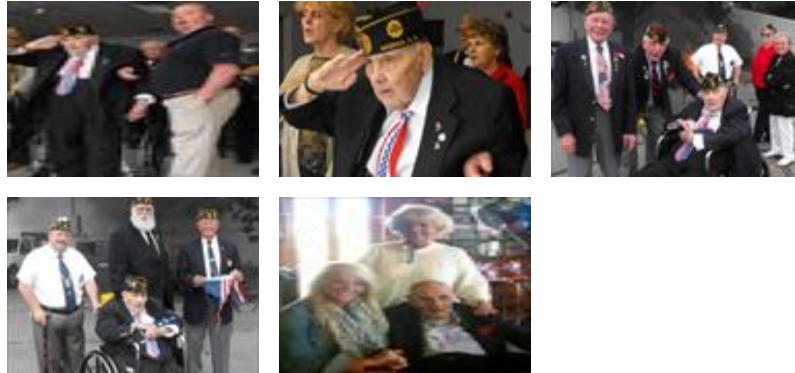
