



## Arnold Beauregard

September 8, 1943 - September 17, 2020

Arnold Henry “Arnie” Beauregard, 77, of Hudson, N.H., died Sept. 17, 2020, after living with the challenges of COPD for many years and a brief battle with cancer.

Arnie was born Sept. 8, 1943, in Gardner, Mass., the son of Norman and Jeannette (Manseau) Beauregard.

He was a longtime resident of Hudson, N.H., and worked for many years at Digital Equipment Corp., which became DEC, Compaq and, at the time of his retirement as a program manager in the early 2000s, Hewlett-Packard.

He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1963 to 1966, earning an honorable discharge, and was a life member of the American Legion. An active member of Hudson Post 48, he formerly served on the executive board and was acting adjutant at the time of his death. He considered the post his second home, and his fellow members his second family.

In his leisure time he enjoyed golf, fishing, hunting, and spending time with family and friends.

He was predeceased by his parents, as well as brothers David Beauregard, Timothy Beauregard and Allen Beauregard.
