Baron Wright, 62, of Hudson, NH, passed away on Monday, February 14, 2022 after a brief illness.

He was born on July 8, 1959 in Greenville, SC, son of Starlin Tucker (S.T.) and Bertha (Cunningham) Wright. After graduating from Spartanburg High School in 1977, Baron enlisted in the U.S. Army, attaining the rank of Sergeant by the age of 20. He served at Fort Hood, TX, as well as in Germany and in Hawaii. After being honorably discharged from the army, he joined the NH National Guard out of Somersworth, and participated in Desert Storm.

Baron worked for the V.A. Hospital in Boston, MA and in 1995 was hired by the U.S. Postal Service, recently retiring from the Manchester, NH facility.

Baron was an avid automobile enthusiast who enjoyed cruising the highways and backroads of his adopted state of New Hampshire. He especially loved the Lakes Region and the seacoast.

A proud veteran, Baron's motto was always "united we stand, divided we fall."

Baron is survived by his long term partner of 26 years, Sandra Hernandez. He is survived by a stepson, Michael Martinez of Hudson, NH, a stepdaughter Bianca and her husband Jose "Chickey" Hernandez of Lowell, MA, and

stepson Sean and his wife Jessica, also of Lowell. He was the beloved "Papu" of three grandchildren, Heli, Scarlett and Evergreen. Also surviving Baron is his sister Bobbye Jean (Wright) Mobley of Fuquay Varina, NC and his nephew Buford Mobley Jr. and his wife Sheila. He is predeceased by a brother Charles Thomas Mobley and a nephew Travis Mitchell Mobley (husband of Raicynda).
