Camille (Vachon) Beaudry, 59, of Hudson, died Sunday, May 24, 2009 at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua surrounded by her loving family.

She was born July 5, 1949 in Sanford, ME, daughter of the late Dr. Robert D. and Pauline (Belanger) Vachon.

Camille was the wife of Robert A. Beaudry of Hudson with whom she shared 37 years of marriage.

She was a Hudson resident for 37 years and was a parishioner of St. John the Evangelist Church.

Camille received a BS in Biology from Trinity College (Vermont) 1971 and worked for a short time in the laboratory at St Joseph Hospital. The majority of her career was spent at Elliot Hospital in Manchester. She worked approximately 35 years in the microbiology laboratory at Elliot.

Camille's first love was her family and some of her happiest moments were spent with them near the ocean in Maine.
