



## Charles Winston Clark, Jr.

May 25, 1958 - December 11, 2022

Charles “Chuck” Winston Clark, Jr., Esquire passed away on Sunday, December 11, 2022.

Chuck was born May 25, 1958, at Saint Joseph’s Hospital in Nashua New Hampshire, son of the late Charles Winston Clark and Genevieve (Golas) Clark. He was also predeceased by his infant brother David Clark.

Chuck went to Bishop Guertin High School, St. Anselm’s College, and Franklin Pierce Law School. He became an attorney and passed the Bars in both New Hampshire and Massachusetts. He practiced law for a few years, but didn’t find the work fulfilling, so he applied and was hired to work at the Internal Revenue Service where he worked for over 35 years. He retired April 2021.

While working at the IRS, Chuck was an active union steward with the National Treasury Employees Union Chapter 68, always fighting for the rights of abused employees. He served on the Chapter’s executive board for many years and was a strong ardent fighter for employee rights.

Chuck was a strong Roman Catholic, and a Latin Right Misa Cantata Mass will be celebrated for him at St. Stanislaus Church in Nashua, NH, time to be announced later.

Chuck's loving family includes his sister Brenda M. Clark of Nashua and brother Alan M. Clark of Nashua. Chuck is also survived by his life partner Michael W. Boulton of Merrimack, New Hampshire. He is also survived by an aunt Anita Taylor and her husband Ron of Utah, his cousins Jimmy Salem and Danny Salem of Lawrence Massachusetts. He will be sorely missed by his close friends Hai Min Huynh and Darwin "Chad" Martinez.

A Graveside Service will be held on Thursday, December 29th at 1pm. All may meet at St. Patrick Cemetery, 75 Derry Road in Hudson, NH.
