David Bernier, 72, of Hudson, New Hampshire, passed away peacefully at his home on Friday, February 6, 2026, following a long term illness.

“ My brother had many names. David, Dave, Davey, Dad, Bro, Pepere, Pep, Uncle Dave, The Frenchman & even Cutie Petutie. - His most treasured part of his life were family & Friends. Don't know anyone else having as many friends from childhood through out life. - A few wks ago while visiting him at the hospital we reminisced of childhood memories. A story we laughed about was when he was 8/9 yrs. old. He was going to the bathroom, my Grandmother flung open the door in such a rush, she didn't see him sitting there and almost sat on him He let out the biggest scream scaring the heck out of our Grandmother. - There were 6 yrs between us, i was his little shadow following him around, wanted to be just like him when I grew up. When he was 15/16, He worked at Alexanders. He always left for work with his blue apron and ink stamping gun. When he wasn't around, I would take the ink gun, stamp all the can goods and everything else in the house, boy did I get in trouble. - Dave was obsessed with the Beatles, loved playing their songs on his guitar with Larry Richards in the attic on Farmount St. As many of you know he looked just like John Lennon always wore the same round glasses. When my Sister Robin was little and time for bed, jhe would rub her back till she fell asleep singing Hey Jude. - My Brother Wayne was his cohort. They always played tricks on me. I remember, after dave got his license, he sometimes had to drive us to St. Margarets to attend Sunday mass. One time Dave & Wayne decided we were going to skip mass that day & go to Maryloo donut. I knew nothing about it. It didn't work out because as Dave was leaving from in front of the church, he hit a parked car. Don't know if we ever went to Maryloo's. - Dave met the love of his life, Colleen in Jr. High & were together for 56 years. - Dave's 2nd love of his life was his daughter Kelley who he sometimes refered to as "the little girl in curls". The Father/Daughter bond was so strong. Kelley told me a story of how he would do anything for her. When she worked at Boston Medical on 2nd shift, she had to park down the street walking to the hospital. Dave wasn't going to let her walk in Boston at 11/12 am. Hw would actually drive her in & pick her up every night for about 3 months until she got a job closer to home. Imagine driving 2-3 hours every night to get her back and forth.

*Kelley, he will always be looking over you . -There was also a strong Father/Son in law bond with Mark. He would be there to help Dave with anything. - Dave adored his two Grandkids, Markie & Jake. They were very close & so proud of them both Over the last several yrs. specifically, they would always check in on him and help him with his physical limitations. Dave was their Hero & at the same time, they were his heroes. - Dave was selfless with his family. He took Moe in when she was little & together he & Colleen raised her as their own. Also cherished his nieces and nephews. On 1/13 the day after he went back in the hospital with the flu, had & exhausting day, we got a phon call at 11:57 pm. We were horrified what it could be but it was Dave on the other line wanting to talk to Kristen. He wanted to call her before midnight because it was her Birthday, & he hadn't wished he a Happy Birthday yet .Kristen described him as "the biggest teddy bear, with the best hugs, most caring & kind personality & had a heart of Gold. 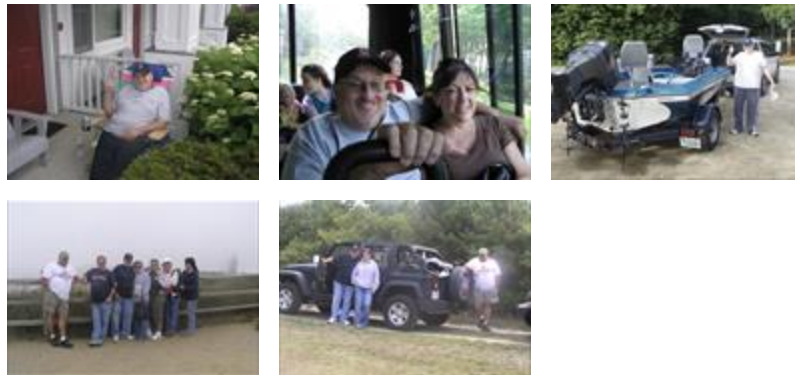

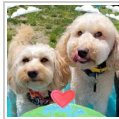
