David Donohue, 69, died peacefully April 6, 2021 at Saint Joseph Hospital, Nashua, NH after a long illness.

Mr. Donohue was born in Worcester, MA on April 20, 1951 to the late Eileen (O'Brien) Donohue and John Donohue. He moved to Nashua in 1961 living in the family home until his passing.
