Don Juan Jackson, 90, passed away in his home in Hudson, NH, in the early hours of June 1, 2025. He was born in Hudson on August 14, 1934, to Elmer P. and Aurore (Rioux) Jackson.

He is survived by his daughter Lisa Jackson of Hudson, NH; his son Don Jackson of Auburn, NH; his sister Celia St. Amand of Milford, NH, and his brother William Jackson of Louisiana.

He was predeceased by his wife of almost 70 years, Beverly Jackson; three brothers: James Jackson, Raymond Jackson, and Ovilla Jackson; and his sister, Shirley Makosky.

Don graduated from Alvirne High School, served three years in the U.S. Army, and then had a diverse engineering career that spanned drafting, electronics, and mechanical design. Always curious, he studied numerous topics throughout his life. After retiring in the late 1980s, he enjoyed investing. He loved being outdoors, growing vegetables in the summer months, and maintaining his property year-round. He also brought his conscientious and studious nature to participating in, and eventually leading, a Senior Bible Study group at Nashua Baptist Church. A stroke at age 75 slowed him down a little, but he continued working around the yard and even planted a tomato garden just weeks before his passing.

He'll be remembered for his deep conversations, sharp insights, and the fullness of his life. Making it to his nineties surprised him, but he felt blessed. After Beverly's passing, daily visits from his daughter, monthly visits with his sister, and dining out with friends brought him great joy.

A Time of visitation will be held on Wednesday June 11th from 10am-11am with a Service of Remembrance at 11am in the Dumont-Sullivan Funeral Home, 50 Ferry Street in Hudson. Burial will be held immediately following in Westview Cemetery in Hudson.

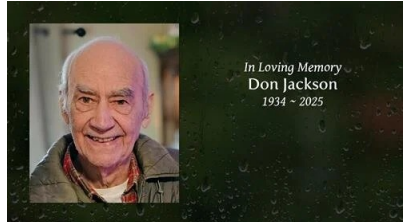
