Donald O. Dumais, 51 of Hudson, died Saturday September 8, 2012 at Southern NH Medical Center following a brief illness.

He was born May 30, 1961 in Nashua, son of the late Roger and Therese (Bernatchez) Dumais.

Donald was an artist who loved classic cars, solving crossword puzzles, and operating radio controlled planes, cars, and boats.

Following an accident at age 19 which left him paralyzed, Donald persevered through 32 years of life's challenges and blessings.

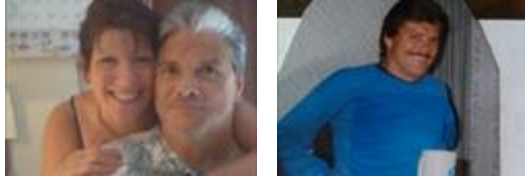
