



## Donna Robinson

October 19, 1942 - April 26, 2021

Donna Louise (Ball) Robinson, 78, passed away Monday April 26, surrounded by her children, after a short battle with lung cancer. She was born October 19, 1942, in Concord VT, and lived most of her life in Hudson NH on Dugout Road.

She was an avid reader, a crossword puzzle aficionado, the Boston Celtics' #1 Fan, and she belonged to the Hannah Dustin Quilt Guild of Hudson. She made many quilts for loved ones, and also donated many of them to David's House, a lodging facility related to Dartmouth Hitchcock Hospital in Lebanon that harbors families of patients during treatment.

Donna was a beloved Mom, sister, friend, Aunt, Grammie and Great Grammie. Her family and her people were the joys of her life -- she was "Mom" to many and welcomed everyone to her kitchen table for a meal, coffee, or just a chat.

Donna was predeceased by her parents, Carlo "Chief" and Mabel Calacci, Louise Rook Morrison, and Baxter Ball, as well as her older brother Bruce Ball. She is survived by her children: Alan & Sue Robinson of Londonderry, Caryn & Steve Hallock of N Palm Beach FL, Denis Robinson of Manchester NH, and Paul & Patricia Robinson of Merrimack NH.

Survivors also include her 8 grandchildren -- Chris, Rafe, Kyle, Jolie, Gabrielle, Vivian, Zachary & Grant -- and her two great grandchildren, Hadleigh and Rory. She also is survived by her brothers, Gary Calacci and his wife Penney of Charlotte VT, Terry Ball of Manchester NH, and Richard Ball of Passumpsic VT.
