Earl W. Morrill, 86, a resident of Hudson since 1997, died Friday April 15, 2011 at his residence.

He was born December 15, 1924 in Newburyport, MA son of the late Frank and Lillian (Petersen) Morrill. He was the husband of the late Anne (Morton) Morrill and was also predeceased by a son Barry Morrill, and two brothers Charles and Willard.
