Eileen Corbeille, R.N., fell asleep in the Lord on October 2, 2014 at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua after a sudden illness.

Eileen was born in Vancouver, British Columbia, the daughter of the late Gordon and Olive (Fleming) LeDuke. She was also predeceased by her brother, Daniel.

Eileen is survived by her husband Bob, whom she met at the Shippensburg Bible School, and her two daughters, Rachel and Nicole. She was baptized in 1983 into the saving name of Christ at the Christadelphian Ecclesial Hall in Toronto Ont. and strived to live life after the commandments of Christ.

She was a registered nurse who was employed at Southern NH Medical Center and St. Joseph Hospital, both in Nashua. Eileen enjoyed bible study, being a Sunday school teacher, and spending time with her family.
