



## Frederick Kearns

March 14, 1934 - February 12, 2026

Frederick Kearns, 91, of Nashua, passed away peacefully at his residence on Thursday, February 12, 2026.

Born on March 14, 1934, in Lowell, MA, he was the son of the late James and Clarice (Walker) Kearns. Fred was predeceased by his beloved wife of 34 years, Joan (O'Sullivan) Kearns; his sister, Virginia Norton; his brother, James Kearns; and his daughter-in-law, Stella (DiPerri) Kearns.

Fred was raised in Somerville MA and Baltimore, MD. He proudly served his country in the United States Navy from 1950 to 1953 during the Korean War. After his military service, he made his home in Revere MA for many years before moving to Salem NH shortly before his retirement. He remained in Salem until taking residence at Aynsley Place in Nashua, where he spent his later years.

Fred was an avid reader throughout his life and found great enjoyment in watching western television shows and movies. He was especially fond of films starring Clint Eastwood. He also loved music, with Johnny Cash being one of his all-time favorite artists.

Fred is lovingly survived by his three children: James (Eddie) Kearns and his companion, Monica Louisos, of Wilmington NC; Catherine Fiore and her

husband, Alessio, of Hudson; and Frederick Kearns Jr. and his wife, Annette (Day) Kearns, of Portsmouth, RI. He also leaves behind four cherished grandchildren: Kelly Ann Thomas and her husband, Eddie, of Derry; Kristina McLaughlin and her husband, Ryan, of Hudson; Christopher Kearns of Portsmouth RI; and Matthew Kearns and his wife, Emily, of Portsmouth RI. Fred was also the proud great-grandfather of six beloved great-granddaughters: Kallie, Gracie, Madisyn, Sadie, Melody, and Mila.

Following cremation, a time of visitation will be held on Wednesday, February 18th, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., with a Service of Remembrance at 11:30 a.m. at the Dumont-Sullivan Funeral Home, 50 Ferry Street, Hudson, NH. Burial will be private.
