Gary Michael Buzzell, 64 of Hudson, NH died Wednesday January 9, 2013 at the Southern NH Medical Center in Nashua surrounded by his loving family.

He was born May 31, 1948 in North Adams, MA, son of Genevieve (Klawitter) Buzzell of Wilmington, DE and the late Harold Buzzell.

Gary was the husband of Debbie (Ashton) Buzzell of Hudson, with whom he shared 35 years of marriage.

Gary was a Marine Veteran having served in the Da Nang area of Vietnam and was a member of the American Legion Post 48 in Hudson. He was currently employed as a rural carrier for the U.S. Postal Service in Londonderry, NH and previously owned and operated Redford Auto Simonize in Hudson.
