Gary Webster, 74, of Hudson, died Monday, October 21, 2019 at his residence in Hudson with his beloved wife, Connie, by his side.

He was born August 21, 1945 in Nashua, son of the late Darrell and Mildred (Johnson) Webster.

Gary was the husband of Connie (Paquette) Webster of Hudson with whom he shared 48 years of marriage.

He was a member of the Department of NH's American Legion Baseball Board since 1984 and held the position of Chairman for over 20 years. 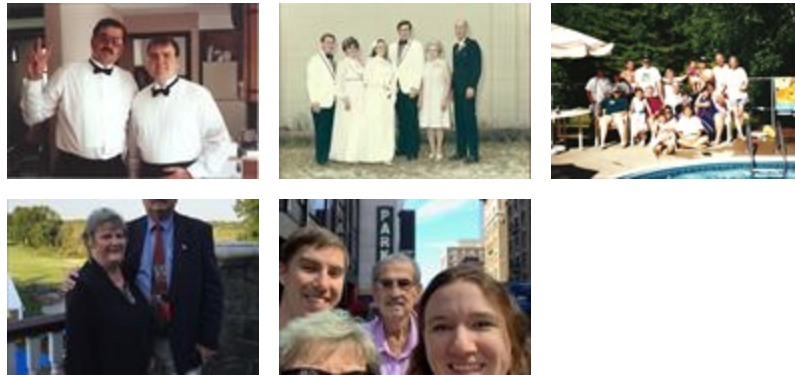
