



## Grant "Bud" Dearborn

August 3, 1931 - February 23, 2012

Grant W. Dearborn, 80, of Hudson, NH died Thursday February 23, 2012 at Southern NH Medical Center surrounded by his loving family.

"Bud" was born on August 3, 1931 in Gloucester, MA son of the late Wayne and Anne (Carroll) Dearborn and was the loving husband of Joan (Kalil) Dearborn of Hudson and was also predeceased by a brother Gregory Dearborn.

Bud was a graduate of Nashua High class of 1949 and went on to serve honorably in the Navy Air Corps until his discharge in 1952. Bud attended aviation TAC School in NY and Electric Instrument School in FL.
