April 27, 1939 - June 14, 2025

Guglielmo Fante, 86, recent resident of Nashua, NH, passed away at his home on Saturday, June 14, 2025 following a period of declining health.

He was born on April 27, 1939, in Colledimezzo (Chieti), Italy, a son of the late Ireneo and Maria (Porfilio) Fante, one of five siblings.

Guglielmo came to the United States in 1967. The following year he met and married his wife, Eleuteria (Fraiole), to whom he was devoted for 57 years. He was a master stonemason who operated his own successful general contracting business in NY state, retiring after over 35 years. He became a proud U.S. citizen in 1982.

He is survived by his wife, Eleuteria Fante, currently of Nashua, NH, his two sons, Mario Fante of Nashua and Fabrizio Fante and his wife Abbey of New York City, his grand-daughter Noelle Fante, and his elder sister Concetta De Laurentiis of Pescara, Italy.

His passions besides his work and family were Italian soccer (Serie A league), Formula 1 racing and vacationing in Italy.

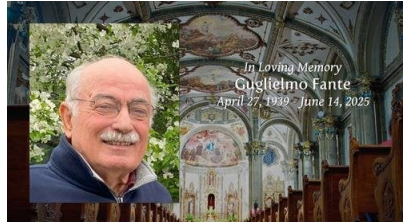
