Hugh Michael O'Neill, 82, of Hollis, NH, died Monday, September 12th, 2022 at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua. He was born July 26th, 1940 to Irish immigrant parents Ellen (Whooley) O'Neill and Michael F. O'Neill.

In 1958 Hugh graduated from Billerica high school and went into the US army for 2 years. Once home, Hugh took a position at the MITRE corporation, where he would stay until his retirement in 2000.

He married Jane M. (Kelley) O'Neill in 1967 and they soon built a home in Hollis NH, where they raised three children- Michael, Christopher and Kathleen. Hugh, or "Huck," as his childhood friends called him, was a lover of nature and the outdoors, spending his time creating a beautiful yard and gardens and reading contentedly on his back porch. He also coached little league, pitched for the MITRE softball team and took up golf in his later years.

Proud of his parents and his Irish heritage, he is survived by his wife and children, sister Ellen, daughter in-law Sharon, son in-law Timothy, his four grandchildren- Cogan, Devlin, Elsie and Miles, and many nieces and nephews. Hugh is predeceased by his parents and three sisters- Mary, Anne and Jean. Gone but not forgotten~ May the road rise to meet him.

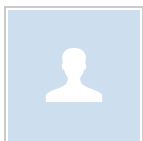
