Jane Marcelina (Grandmaison) Stancombe, 90, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, December 23, 2025.

Jane was born in Nashua, New Hampshire, on March 29, 1935, to Emile and Mary (Hennessey) Grandmaison. She grew up in Nashua and attended Nashua schools.
