Janice Dorine Conway, 75, of Hudson, NH, died Thursday, December 6, 2018 at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua, following brief illness.

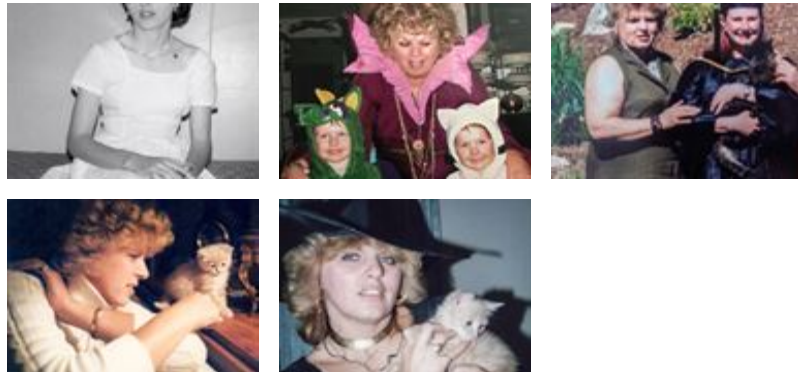

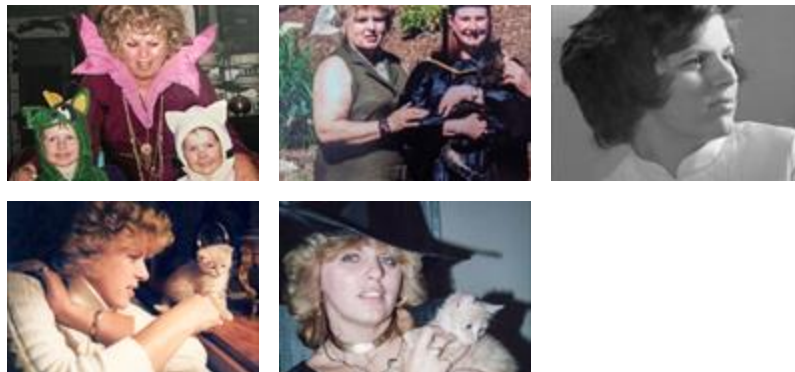

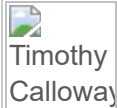
