John Patrick Nesbitt, 63, of Beverly, Massachusetts and Roan Mountain, Tennessee, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, November 3, 2025.

Born on August 4, 1962, in Salem, Massachusetts, John grew up in Beverly before settling in Nashua, New Hampshire with his beloved wife and children.

John proudly served his country in the United States Air Force. Following his military service, he began his career with the Department of Defense before transitioning to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), allowing him to return home to New England. Over his remarkable 37-year career in government service, John contributed greatly to the aviation community. He began as an engineering technician in the Environmental Unit and played a key role in the construction of the Boston Consolidated TRACON in 2004. In 2009, he was promoted to Environmental Supervisor of the TRACON, a position he held until his retirement in 2019.

He was predeceased by his parents, Thomas and Elizabeth (Betty) Nesbitt, and his parents-in-law, Mary and James Turner. He is survived by his siblings Susan Locke and her husband John, Eileen Hadley and her husband John, Timothy Nesbitt, and Thomas Nesbitt and his wife Marilyn Curry, along with nine nieces and nephews who will remember him fondly.
