Joseph Paladino, 86, of Nashua, NH died Wednesday June 27, 2012 at Southern NH Medical Center surrounded by his loving family.

Joe, or “Babby” as he was known to his friends in Utica, was born on November 5, 1925 in Utica, NY son of the late Dominick and Anna (Bilotta) Paladino and was the loving husband of Helen (Carney) Paladino who passed away in 2011 with whom he shared over 53 years of marriage.
