Joseph Patrick Earabino, 83 of Hudson, NH died Saturday March 6, 2010 at the Southern NH Medical Center in Nashua surrounded by his loving family.

He was born November 1, 1926 in Beverly, MA son of the late Patrick and Mary (Tanzella) Earabino.

Joseph was the husband of the late Anastasia (Cavanaugh) Earabino who died in September of 1998. He was also predeceased by a brother; Richard Earabino.
