Joseph Rocco Catanzaro, 76, of Hudson, NH, Died Sunday September 11, 2011 at the Community Hospice House in Merrimack, NH surrounded by his loving family.

Joseph was born on June 21, 1935 in Boston, MA son of the late Joseph L. and Viola (Venezia) Catanzaro. He was also predeceased by a brother, Michael Catanzaro and a sister Janice Lenzi. Joseph was the loving husband to Joyce M. (Sewell) Catanzaro with whom he shared 56 years of marriage.
