Judith Ann Dubowik (McDonough), 55, of Derry Rd., Hudson, died after her courageous battle with cancer ended early Monday morning December 2, 2013 at Merrimack Valley hospice House in Haverhill Massachusetts surrounded by family.

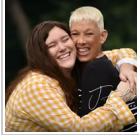
