Justin Dennis Marandos, 43, passed away suddenly at Southern New Hampshire Medical Center on January 5, 2021, from a non-COVID related illness. He was born and raised in Nashua, New Hampshire. Justin was the son of Dennis and Caroline (Bach) Marandos. Justin graduated from Nashua High School in 1996, and Plymouth State College in 2004. Following in his family's footsteps, he began to work for the Nashua School District. First, at Nashua High South and then at Fairgrounds Middle School for the next 15 years in a variety of educational roles. He had a good rapport with students and colleagues, and will always be a "Falcon" at heart.

Justin is survived by his daughters Brady and Kendall. He will be greatly missed by his brother Jason, sister-in-law Heidi, and two nephews Joshua and Sam.
