Karen (Modry) Bosco, 59 of Hudson died following a courageous battle with cancer on Tuesday April 26, 2011 at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua. She was surrounded by her loving family.

She was born February 18, 1952 in Portland, Maine daughter of Alice (Abare) Modry of Marstons Mills, MA and the late Joseph Modry.

Karen was the wife of John Bosco of Hudson with whom she would have shared 39 years of marriage on this Friday, April 29th.

Karen was employed with Teledyne in Hudson as a Site Controller for 25 years until she retired in 2010. She volunteered with the United Way serving on their finance Committee and enjoyed planting flowers and travelling to the beach.
