Kevin M. Nute, 55, of Hudson, NH, died peacefully on Sunday, July 3, 2016 at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, MA, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born September 9, 1960 in Nashua, son of the late Charles and Frances (Bibeau) Nute.

Kevin was the husband of Debbie (Duston) Nute of Hudson, with whom he shared 31 years of marriage.

He was a graduate of Bishop Guertin High School, Class of 1978, and a graduate of WPI where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering. He later received his Master's Degree in Electrical Engineering from Northeastern University. Kevin was employed with Sanders / BAE for 15 years.

Because of his love for math and bright personality, he later pursued teaching and tutoring math in both the towns of Litchfield and Kingston. Kevin also enjoyed spending every Sunday with his family, playing cribbage and hearts.

Besides his loving wife Debbie, survivors include a daughter, Elizabeth Nute of Merrimack, NH, a son, Brian Nute and his fiancée Michelle Tremblay of

Somerville, MA, two brothers, William Nute and his wife Susan of East Hampstead, NH, Stephen Nute and his wife Lisa of Hudson, NH, as well as many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

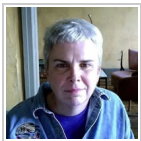
