Over the years he also coached baseball at both the youth and high school level. Kurt

was also honored to have served with the Litchfield Board of Selectmen for 3 year and was the representative to the Recreation Committee. He was particularly proud of his contribution to the approval and construction of the new fire station in Litchfield.
