Lorraine (Allard) Spencer, 65 of Nashua, died Thursday, February 12, 2009 at her residence in the care of her loving family.

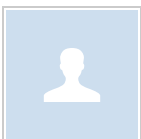

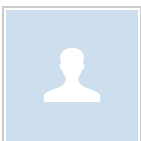
