Margaret Barrett, 74, of Hudson, NH, died on Sunday, May 15, 2016 at Southern NH Medical Center in Nashua.

She was born August 13, 1941 in Keene, NH, daughter of the late Walter and Mathilde (Stader) Roehrig. She was also predeceased by her sister, Hildegard Anderson.

Margaret was the beloved wife of Thomas Barrett of Hudson, with whom she shared 50 years of marriage and recently celebrated this event with nearly her entire wedding party in attendance.

At one time, she was employed as a school teacher and later as a teller at Nashua Trust in Hudson before retiring from BAE Systems. She began her married life in Hawaii while her husband served in the navy and cherished her time there.
