June 11, 1919 - August 19, 2011

Marion Loretta (Brennan) Chaisson lived independently and died peacefully at home in Nashua, NH, on August 20th.

She was born on June 11, 1919 in Lowell, Massachusetts, the first daughter of Thomas and Rose Brennan.
