Mary V. (Murphy) Dunn, 80, of Nashua passed away peacefully on Friday March 4, 2022 at the Community Hospice House in Merrimack, NH.

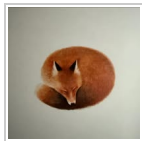
