



## Matthew Reddig

September 16, 1966 - September 3, 2024

Matthew Donald Reddig, a long-time resident of Hudson, NH, died on September 3, 2024 at his home.

Born September 16, 1966, in Nashua, NH, the son of Frances “Betty” E. (Peckham) Reddig-Barry and the late Kenneth Reddig.

Matt’s life centered around his two sons, Zachary and Connor, his customers, and his beloved 1969 Camaros.

He was a 1985 graduate of Alvirne High School. Matt purchased his first canteen truck in 1989. For 35 years, he owned and operated Spring Hill Catering, delivering breakfast and lunch to businesses throughout southern New Hampshire. Matt, frequently referred to as “Matty,” became life-long friends with many of his daily customers. He often brought a smile to their faces by remembering the meaningful things going on in their lives or through his goofy antics.

Matt furthered his entrepreneurial pursuits in 2010 when he began A.C.E. New England Fire Protection. He enjoyed working on his muscle cars, attending car shows, going to New England sporting events, watching Jeopardy, deep sea fishing, hosting parties (formerly pronounced ‘Matt Bash’) and documenting his many good times with his family and friends.

Matt is survived by his two sons, Zac and Connor; his mother, Betty Reddig-Barry and step-father Ray Barry of Merrimack, NH; a sister, Tricia Eastman and her husband, Derek of Merrimack, NH; a brother, Tim, of St. Petersburg, FL; step-siblings, Michael Barry and Tracy Rivera; six nephews, Cooper and Tyler Reddig, Jared Rodriguez, Pierce and Toby Eastman, and Brandon Barry; a niece, Addison Barry; and his two cherished dogs, Lulu and Zuko (aka a\*\*\*\*\*).

Matt was a caring and generous father, son, brother, uncle, and friend. He frequently invited loved ones to Red Sox games and he always picked up the tab when out to eat with them. His nephews always anticipated their birthday and Christmas gifts from him the most.

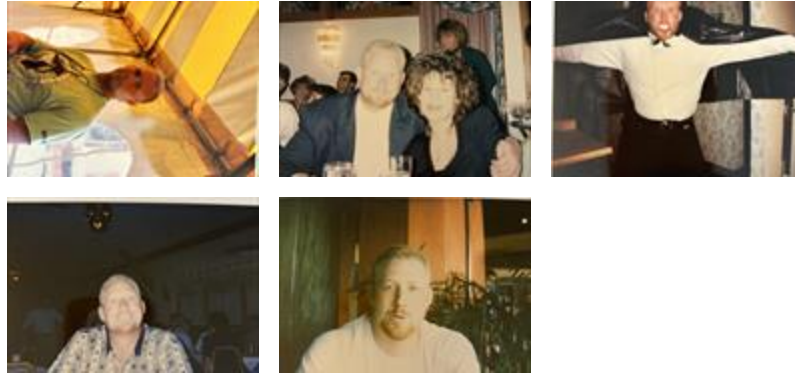

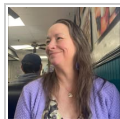
