Michael A. Celata Jr., 70, of Hudson, NH died Mon. Oct. 20, 2008 at the Lahey Clinic in Burlington, MA.

Michael was born in Arlington, MA on April 14, 1938 eldest son of the late Michael Sr. and Julia (Hermandinger) Celata and married to Michelina (Febbi) Celata, of Hudson with whom he shared 49 years of marriage.

Mike was educated in the Medford Public Schools and went on to enter the US Marine Corps. While in the Marines, he became the Heavyweight Boxing Champion of the 3rd Division with a record of 33 wins and 3 losses. He then went on to become a police officer for the town of Wilmington, MA where he became a detective specializing in fingerprinting after graduating from the FBI in Quantico, VA.
