Norman Alfred Nadeau, 94, of Nashua, NH, loving husband of the late Ethel Nadeau, passed away on December 7, 2015 at the SNHMC, Nashua, NH. Born on October 26, 1921 in Nashua, Norman was the son of the late Edmond and Bertha Fortin Nadeau.

He was co-owner of E.E. Nadeau and Sons welding company of Nashua for many years until his retirement. After retiring, he continued to work part-time for Kopper's Tie Plant and on the maintenance crew of Whip-Poor-Will Golf Course. Most recently he was a daily volunteer for Meals on Wheels at the Nashua Senior Center.

Fittingly, Norman departed on the anniversary of Pearl Harbor Day. He served in the United States Navy during WWII as a 2nd Class Gunner's Mate on PT-346 RON 25 in the South Pacific.

Norman was an avid golfer and a former member of the Nashua Country Club. He most recently played in the Senior's League at Whip-Poor-Will Golf Course in Hudson, NH. He continued to enjoy golf through September of this year.

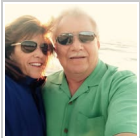
