Norman B. Roy III, 82 of Nashua died Tuesday March 22, 2011 at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua following a brief illness.

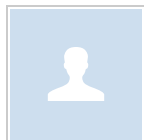

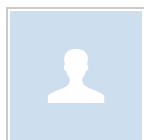

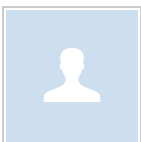
