Owen Douglas Surprenant, age 19, of Hudson, New Hampshire, passed away on Friday, February 20, at Southern New Hampshire Medical Center due to complications from a recent surgery.

Born on October 21, 2006, in Nashua, New Hampshire, Owen was the beloved son of Douglas and Christie Surprenant of Hudson, NH. He was a devoted brother to Kyle Surprenant of Hudson, NH, and a cherished grandson to Susan Rector of Pelham, NH, and Albina Guillotte of Hudson, NH.

Owen attended Alvirne High School, where he made a lasting impression both on and off the field.
