One of the family's longest and best traditions, which was loved by Patricia, was getting together on Friday nights as a family, where a lot of us got together to catch up on family news/events and celebrated birthdays. Grandchildren were her greatest joy. She spoiled them by spending time with them. She never missed a chance to babysit or just have them over to spend the night, and always serving crêpes for breakfast.

Patricia was always welcoming, always smiling. She was very nurturing and taught her children by example. She was a true friend and confidante to many and an absolutely wonderful mother, grandmother and great-grandmother.
