Patricia A. (Barclay) Murphy, 64 of Hudson, NH, beloved wife of John R. Murphy, Jr. died Monday October 3, 2011 at Fairview Nursing Home in Hudson.

She was born May 27, 1947 in Jersey City, NJ daughter of the late Bertha (Godbout) Barclay.

Patty grew up in Lowell and attended St. Patrick's Grammar School and was a 1965 graduate of Keith Hall and later attended Lowell State. She became a Certified Massage Therapist in 1990, graduating from the NH Institute for therapeutic Arts. Patty was a lifelong participant of Girls Inc. in Lowell (formerly the Girls Club of Lowell) at one time being named girl of the year and more recently being on their Board of Directors.

She was a communicant of St. Kathryn's Parish in Hudson and was a member of the Rivier College RISE program where she found a love for painting and developed many strong friendships. She enjoyed travelling, painting, and taking cruises.

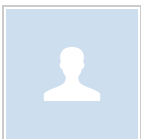
