



## Pauline R. Madigan

Pauline R. Madigan peacefully passed after a brief illness on August 16, 2024, with family by her side at the young age of 92. She was the daughter of the late Alfred and Lena Bois and predeceased by her husband John Madigan whom she was married to for 72 years. She looked forward to her weekly card games with the neighborhood ladies as recently as two weeks ago along with Sunday visits to her sister "Flo's" house.

When at home, you would almost always find her doing her word searches on the porch, but only after hanging her laundry outside, polishing her windows

and ensuring everything was in its proper place. She loved sharing stories of the younger years and was known to be the shortest, yet the most determined and strong soul of the family. She was the quintessential mother and Grammy.
