Pearl Rosena (Austin) Ritter, 85 of Hudson, NH died Friday January 25, 2013 at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua, NH following a brief illness.

She was born December 27, 1927 in Booth's Corner, PA, daughter of the late Herman and Idella (Green) Austin. She was predeceased by her husband, S.
