Peter David Varhol, 64, of Nashua, NH, passed away on Sunday, January 9, 2022 at Lahey Hospital in Burlington, MA. Peter was the son of the later Peter Varhol and Ann (Barancho) Varhol in Aliquippa, PA.

He was a Captain in the United States Air Force from August 15, 1979 until July 31, 1985 when he received an honorable discharge.
