Philip Szymanowicz, 68 of Nashua, dies Sunday September 29, 2013 at the Southern NH Medical Center in Nashua.

He was born July 4, 1945 in Hadley, MA son of the late Joseph and Helen (Benbem) Szymanowicz.

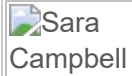
