Robert "Bob" Duquette, 61, of Nashua, NH passed away on Monday June 2, 2025 at the Community Hospice House in Merrimack surrounded by his loving family.

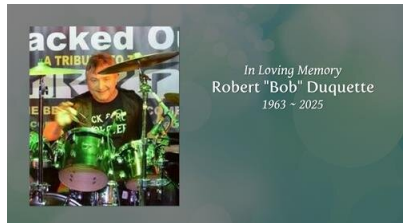
